Glenn Highway & Artillery Road Interchange Improvements



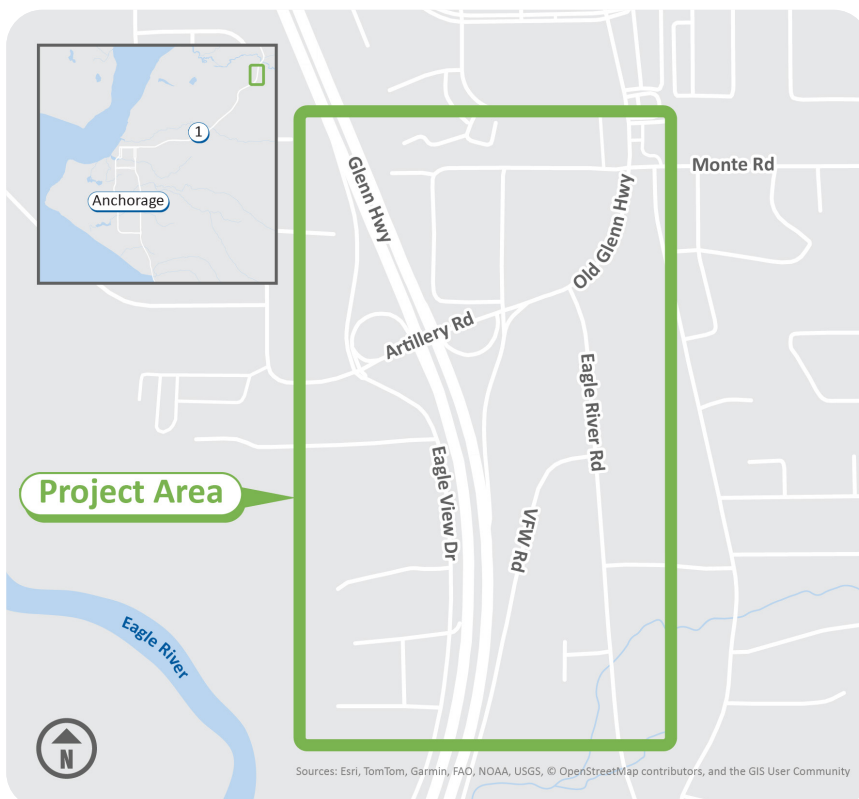

Project Overview

The Alaska Department of Transportation & Public Facilities (DOT&PF) is improving the Glenn Highway and Artillery Road Interchange in Eagle River. The project will replace the aging Artillery Road bridge over the Glenn Highway, modernize the interchange, and reconstruct the highway on- and off-ramps, and may adjust connections with nearby roadways including Artillery Road, Old Glenn Highway, VFW Road, Cross Drive, and Eagle View Drive as needed.

Project Area

This project is located in Eagle River, Alaska and will reconstruct the Glenn Highway and Artillery Road interchange, including replacing the existing bridge. Project area roadways adjacent to the interchange include Artillery Road, Glenn Highway on- and offramps, Old Glenn Highway, VFW Road, and Eagle View Drive.



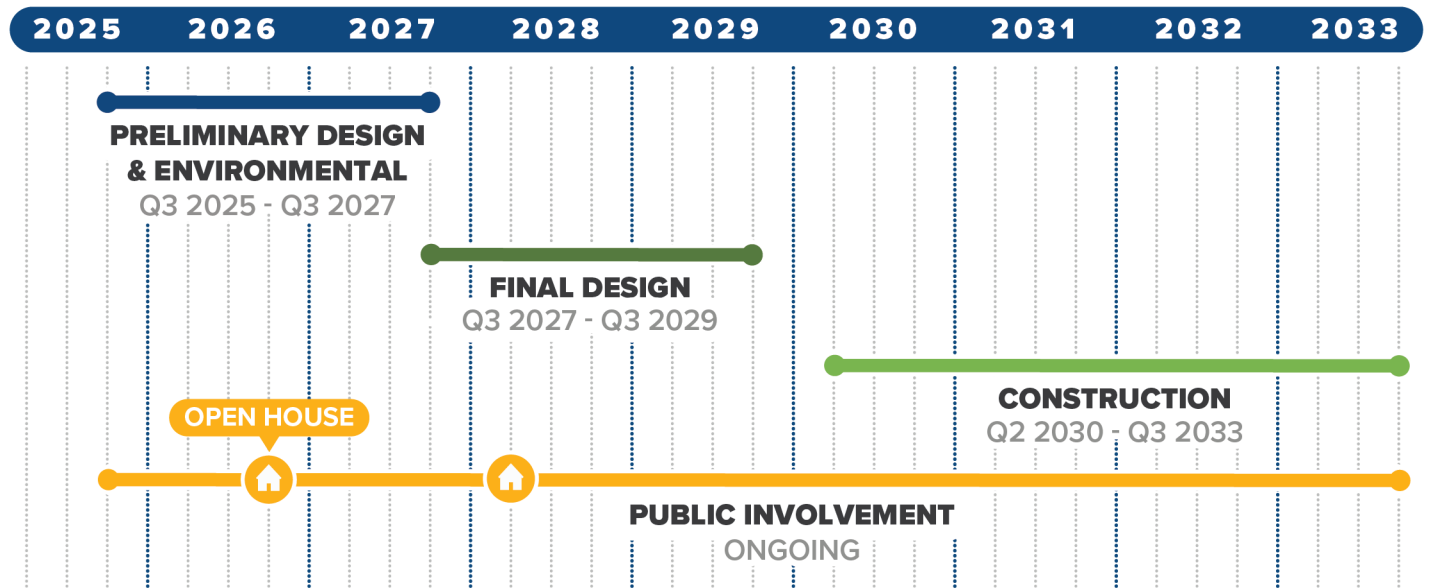
Key Goals:

- Improve safety, traffic flow, and connectivity for all users.
- Enhance non-motorized travel by adding or improving sidewalks, curb ramps, and shared-use pathways.
- Upgrade essential infrastructure, including paving and drainage improvements, lighting, signage and striping, guardrails, retaining walls, landscaping, and other roadside features.
- Increase bridge clearance over Glenn Highway to meet current design standards.

Community Benefits:

- Reduce congestion and improve traffic flow.
- Provide safer intersections and travel routes for all users.
- Improve mobility for drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists.
- Improve transit infrastructure and route efficiency within the project limits.
